MS. MORABITO: Hello. My name is
Christine Morabito, and I am the Business
Development Manager for the County of
Chautauqua Industrial Development Agency
(hereafter, the "Agency) and members of the
Agency have directed me to hold this public
hearing. Today is July 18, 2017, and the time
is now 10:01 a.m. We are at the Town of
Dunkirk Town Hall Meeting Room, located at
4737 Willow Road, Dunkirk, County of
Chautauqua, New York.

This is a public hearing pursuant to

Section 895-a of the New York General

Municipal Law, as amended. The Agency has

received an application for financial

assistance in connection with the following

matter (which I will refer to as the

"Project):

The Agency received an application from Athenex Inc., a publicly held corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Delaware and qualified to do business in the State of New York as a foreign business

corporation. The application describes

Athenex as a "global biopharmaceutical company dedicated to becoming a leader in the discovery, development, and commercialization of next generation drugs for the treatment of cancer." I will refer to Athenex during this public hearing as the Applicant.

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The Applicant presented an application to the Agency, that requested that the Agency consider undertaking a Project consisting of the following: (A) (1) the acquisition of an interest, by sublease, in an approximately 33.6 acre parcel of vacant land located at 3799 Lake Shore Drive East, Dunkirk, County of Chautauqua, New York, (the "Land"), (2) the construction of an approximately 320,000 square foot building, (the "Building") on the Land with potential parking, landscaping, and related improvements to the Land (together with the Building, the "Facility"), and (3) the acquisition and installation therein and thereon of certain furniture, fixtures, machinery, and equipment (the "Equipment), all of the foregoing for use by the Applicant as a biopharmaceutical manufacturing facility (collectively, the "Project Facility"); (B) the granting of certain "financial assistance" (within the meaning of Section 854(14) of the Act) with respect to the foregoing, including potential exemptions or partial exemptions from sales and use taxes and real property taxes (collectively, the "Financial Assistance"); and (C) the lease (with an obligation to purchase) or sale of the Project Facility back to the Applicant or such other entity as may be designated by the Applicant and agreed upon by the Agency.

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The Application identifies the Project as an opportunity for a Athenex Inc. to grow its business and become a world leader in manufacturing and distributing products that support cancer treatment. The Applicant estimates that after three years of operation, the Project will employ over four hundred (400) employees with an estimated payroll of nearly \$23 million. The Project is also

estimated to employ over one hundred (100) full time equivalent construction jobs during the construction of the Project.

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With respect to Financial Assistance, the Applicant has requested real property tax abatement and sales tax abatement but did not request any abatement of mortgage recording As to real property taxes, the Applicant made a request for abatement that falls outside of the Agency's Uniform Tax Exemption Policy, that Policy provides the typical schedule for payments in lieu of taxes for Agency projects. The Applicant requested a twenty-year PILOT agreement and requested that it make no PILOT payments for that term. The Applicant indicated that the Project may not occur in Dunkirk without the requested real property tax abatement. Before the Agency can grant the Applicant's request, the members of Agency will need to decide to deviate from its Uniform Tax Exemption Policy, and the members will consider the Applicant's request this month. As to sales tax

abatement, the Applicant requests abatement on portions of the estimated \$208,027,000 project-cost investment that are subject to sales tax.

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The purpose of this hearing is to provide an opportunity for all interested parties from the public to present their views, both orally and in writing, with respect to the Agency's involvement in this Project and the Financial Assistance proposed in the Application. here on behalf of the Agency, not the Applicant. I cannot address any of the specifics of the Project itself; that is the task of the Applicant. During the course of this hearing, the Agency will be unable to respond to comments or questions. The Agency will, however, transcribe all of the comments made by those interested in the Agency's proposed involvement with the Project and provide that transcription to the Agency's Board of Directors.

Notice of this public hearing was published in the Observer on July 8, 2017 and

mailed to the Chief Executive Officer of each 1 affected tax jurisdiction on July 6, 2017. 2 Is there anyone wishing to be heard with 3 respect to the project? 4 MR. MR. MAZGAJ: This will be going to the Board of Directors, so if you want to be part of the record.

MR. PAGAN: Again, my name is Juan

Pagan. I'm a Town Councilman for the Town of

Dunkirk. Like Mr. Purol indicated, we're most

definitely glad that Athenex first of all is

coming in and the IDA is very instrumental in

helping them to whatever process they need,

just like we're doing. So thank you, and I'd

like to have you on board.

MS. MORABITO: Thank you for your comments. And is there anyone else wishing to be heard with respect to the Project? On behalf of the Agency, I would like to thank the members of the public for attending this public hearing and for their comments with respect to the Project. It is now 10:09 a.m.
