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## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

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NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of Chautauqua Industrial Development Agency (the “Agency”) will hold a public hearing on May 15, 2023, at 11:00 a.m., local time, at Fredonia Technology Incubator, 214 Central Avenue, Large Conference Room, City of Dunkirk, County of Chautauqua, New York, pursuant to Section 859-a of the General Municipal Law, as amended (the “Act”). The purpose of the public hearing is to provide an opportunity for all interested parties to present their views with respect to the “Project” and the “Financial Assistance” (as such terms are defined below).

REFRESCO BEVERAGES US, INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and qualified to do business in the State of New York as a foreign corporation (the “Applicant”), presented an application for financial assistance (the “Application”) to the Agency, which Application requested that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the “Project”) consisting of the following: (A)(1) the acquisition of an interest in an approximately 10 acre parcel of land located at 26 E. Talcott Street and E. Talcott Street, County of Chautauqua, New York (the “Land”), (2) the renovation of an existing approximately 243,800 square foot building located on the Land (collectively, the “Building”), and (3) the acquisition of certain furniture, fixtures, machinery and equipment necessary for the completion thereof (the “Equipment” and together with the Land and the Building, collectively, the “Project Facility”), all of the foregoing for use by the Applicant and/or its affiliates as a warehousing and distribution facility; (B) the granting of certain “financial assistance” (within the meaning of Section 854(14) of the General Municipal Law) with respect to the foregoing in the form of potential exemptions or partial exemptions from real property taxes and sales and use taxes (collectively, the “Financial Assistance”); and (C) the lease (with an obligation to purchase), license or sale of the Project Facility to the Applicant or such other entity(ies) as may be designated by the Applicant and agreed upon by the Agency.

The Project Facility would be initially owned, operated and/or managed by the Applicant (or such other entity(ies) designated by the Applicant and approved by the Agency).

The Applicant (or such other designated entity(ies)) would receive the Financial Assistance from the Agency in the form of potential exemptions or partial exemptions from real property taxes and sales and use taxes.

A representative of the Agency will hear and accept any comments that are made orally at the above-stated time and place. Comments may also be submitted to the Agency in writing or electronically to: [morabitk@chqgov.com](mailto:morabitk@chqgov.com).

A representative of the Agency will provide a report or reasonable summary of all such comments to the Agency’s members.
